



XIV CONGRESO ESPAÑOL DE SOCIOLOGÍA

Poster format guidelines

These are graphic displays of communications that have been presented or assigned as posters by the conference working groups. They will be displayed during the session to which they are located, in areas specifically set aside for that purpose. Times and presentation slots will be published in the programme.

Content. Posters will contain:

- Title
- Author or team details
- Introduction
- Aim
- Methods
- Most salient points
- Results or conclusions

Format guidelines:

- Poster size will be a maximum of 100 cm (vertical) by 80 cm (horizontal) and clearly readable from a distance of 1.5 m [recommended size A0: height 100 cm, base 70 cm].
- Printed on paper, card or photographic paper. The material used should not be too thick or heavy, in order to ensure easy fixing to the panel.

Participation procedure:

- Authors must upload a digital version of the poster (maximum size 10 MB) in JPEG or PDF format until **25 March 2022**
- Authors will be responsible for poster printing and carriage costs. On the assigned day and time, the technical secretary will inform authors of where and how to fix the poster.

- Authors are also required to be present at the session venue for presentation and debate. Posters shall be removed once the session is over.

All communications, irrespective of type of presentation format (oral or poster), will be accredited to a single category, "communication", in both the final publication and the certificate issued to participants.
